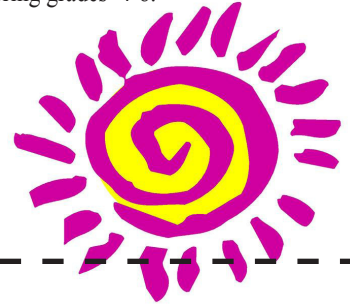
DRAMA WRITERS CAMP
